Kindermusik

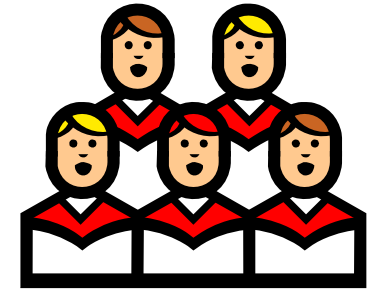
From September through May two levels of the Kindermusik Curriculum are offered by a licensed Kindermusik teacher, who has extensive experience and training in early childhood education. Children aged 18 months through 3 years and their parents meet Wednesdays at 5:00 p.m., while the 3 and 4 year olds meet at 5:45 p.m. These practices culminate with the children's participation in the Christmas and Mother's Day cantata worship services. A fee for the Kindermusik home materials is required.

Children's Choirs

Cherubs (5 year olds), kindergartners, and first graders meet each Wednesday, September through May, at 6:30 p.m. to learn about worship and prepare for monthly participation in the church's worship services. The Cherub Choir also sings Thanksgiving Eve and Christmas Eve. Rehearsals include fun activities, which teach about worship and music as well as the songs to be learned.



Plus we offer the Primary Bells, Ages 5 years old through 2nd grade meeting 7:20 to 7:45 (right after the Cherubs), And participating in worship when prepared



Junior Choir

The Junior Choir at Grove is made up of students who are in second through fifth grades. Practice is on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 till 7:30 p.m.

The Junior Choir sings one Sunday per month at the 11:00 a.m. service, as well as at the Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve, Palm Sunday and Easter Day services.

The Junior Choir performs two annual Cantatas: one near Christmas and the other one on Mother's Day.

In addition to learning songs for church, they learn various musical skills and study biblical principles.

Youth Ensemble

The Youth Ensemble consists of students in sixth through twelfth grade.

They practice on Wednesday nights from 7:30 to 8:00 p.m. in the music room.

They sing one Sunday each month at the 11:00 a.m. worship service.

The Ensemble also performs at the Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and Easter Services

They participate in the Lenten Musical performed in the spring with the Senior Choir.

There is no previous choir experience required to join the Youth Ensemble.

SENIOR CHOIR

The adult choir (known as the Senior Choir) is open to any person in the church who wishes to use his/her voice to praise the Lord.

There is no age requirement, although students must be old enough to sing in the Youth Ensemble to join the Senior Choir. There is no previous vocal training or experience required to join. Just a desire to sing! You can meet with the Choir Director for more information if you are interested in joining.

Rehearsal is on Wednesday nights from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. in the sanctuary. The choir sings weekly at the 11:00 a.m. worship service.

They also sing at evening services such as Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve and Maundy Thursday.

On Sunday mornings practice begins at 10:30 a.m. in the music room to prepare for worship.
