

Seminary Education Scholarship Policy

Eligibility

Applicant is a member in good standing with the Grove Presbyterian Church
Applicant provides proof the student is enrolled in a seminary of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A) for either M.A. or M.Div. degree (ordination track is not necessary for eligibility)
Applicant intends to serve the church in some capacity of professional ministry, whether part time or full time

How to Apply

The applicant writes a letter to Session asking for the scholarship prior to each semester. He or she explains what course of study he or she intends to undertake, a brief statement the nature of his or her Christian faith, and a description of how they hope to serve Christ through church work.

Expectations

Student will provide the session with a copy of their semester report card for each semester completed. A grade point average of less than 2.5 can jeopardize the scholarship from being renewed.
Student will, when able, address the congregation during Sunday worship to discuss what they are studying, what experiences they have had during their time at seminary, and how their understanding of the Christian faith and church has been affected by their seminary experience
Session can fund up to \$750 per semester from the budgeted amount
